



Arrowhead Vine
Syngonium chiapense

Description:

A vine forming variety that is perfect for indoor containers and hanging baskets; features large, arrowhead shaped foliage that are dark green with a slight blue overtone; prefers part to full shade and evenly moist soil

Features & Attributes

Arrowhead Vine's attractive crinkled heart-shaped leaves remain forest green in color with hints of steel blue throughout the year on a plant with a spreading habit of growth.

This is an herbaceous evergreen houseplant with a spreading, ground-hugging habit of growth. This plant can be pruned at any time to keep it looking its best.

Planting & Growing

When grown indoors, Arrowhead Vine can be expected to grow to be about 24 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 8 feet. It grows at a fast rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 10 years. This houseplant performs well in both bright or indirect sunlight and strong artificial light, and can therefore be situated in almost any well-lit room or location. It prefers to grow in average to moist soil. The surface of the soil shouldn't be allowed to dry out completely, and so you should expect to water this plant once and possibly even twice each week. Be aware that your particular watering schedule may vary depending on its location in the room, the pot size, plant size and other conditions; if in doubt, ask one of our experts in the store for advice. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in rich soil. Contact the store for specific recommendations on pre-mixed potting soil for this plant.
